Sam Stowe Campground – Fremont Indian State Park

Arrival: Thursday, June 10, 2021

Departure: Sunday, June 13, 2021

BACKGROUND: *Discover artifacts, petroglyphs, and pictographs left behind by the Fremont Indians. During construction of Interstate 70, the largest known Fremont Indian village was uncovered. The nearby museum preserves treasures from the site, including pottery, baskets, and arrowheads. Spend a day at the museum, take a hike on the trails, and camp at nearby Sam Stowe Campground with your UWAC friends.*



REGISTRATION: *Rally is first-come, first-serve for early registrants. You have three options to choose from. Early-birds can request one of the 5 spots within the Sam Stowe group-site by email @ ron.holly.jorgensen@gmail.com while they last. Costs will be \$35 per night (\$105 total) for three nights for 2 sites with hook-ups, OR \$20 per night (\$60 total) for*

three nights for 3 dry-camp trailers (no hook-ups) within the group-site. Not so early-birds can book their own site (only 7 are available, first-come first-serve) with hook-ups at the Sam Stowe Campground directly on reserveamerica.com at \$35 per night plus booking reservation fee. Note that the Sam Stowe campground allows booking only 4-months in advance, so you'll need to time your booking properly so you don't miss-out. With only 7 spots available in Sam Stowe for Not-so-early-birds, these will go quickly in mid-February; be sure to notify the hosts by email (ron.holly.jorgensen@gmail.com) after you've booked your Not-so-early-bird site.
